

Kids Country Barn Medication Policy

For a child to receive medication while in the care of Kids Country Barn, Kids Country Barn must have the following:

1. A current Medication Authorization Form and Individual Care Plan signed by the parent/guardian of the child
2. A current prescription label of the medication from the child's doctor with the following information:
 - a. The child's first and last name
 - b. Date the prescription was filled
 - c. Name and contact information of the prescribing health professional
 - d. Expiration date
 - e. Dosage amount
 - f. Length of time to give the medication
 - g. Instructions for administration and storage.

Per ADA law, Kids Country Barn administers emergency medications. Kids Country Barn does not administer non-emergency medications.
